You can download new music to your iMac computer using iTunes, a music software package that comes with all new Macs. Open iTunes. Look for an icon that resembles a CD with a music note. iTunes software must come pre-installed on your iMac. In the left menu bar under the Store category, click the iTunes Store. Click the Find Store field in the upper-right corner of the iTunes screen and type the name of the artist you want to search for. You can also search by song name or album. Use the search filters at the top of the screen to ensure that you're viewing only song results. Find the song you want to download and click the Buy button. The song or album will download to your library as soon as you confirm your purchase.
